WALLACE HONORED IN ENGINEERING EXCELLENCE AWARD PROGRAM

December 2006 TULSA, Oklahoma -- Wallace Engineering was recently honored with the 2006 Honor Award by the American Council of Engineering Companies of Oklahoma for its engineering design of the Morton Comprehensive Health Services Facility in Tulsa.

Founded in 1921, the Morton Comprehensive Health Services Facility has quite a distinguished history of providing health services to Tulsa's minority and economically disadvantaged population. Morton Health Care had completely outgrown the facility that it had occupied for 71 years and was struggling to provide the after-hours care and emergency room services that its patients needed. Aided by the funding provided by Tulsa's landmark Vision 2025 program, Morton Health Care can now provide the services their clientele needs, as well as have the ability to expand services in the future.

The new \$14 million, 60,000 square foot facility provides space for medical, dental, behavioral health, optometry, podiatry, patient education, social and WIC services. It also houses pharmacy, laboratory and radiology services, as well as health career and after-hours services.

Wallace Engineering provided full-service structural and civil engineering design services for the project. The design team included Selser Schaefer Architects (architects), Phillips & Bacon, Inc. (mechanical/electrical/plumbing), Alaback Design Associates (landscape), Walsh Associates (environmental graphics) and Blasdel Associates, Inc. (food service). Manhattan Construction was the construction manager for the facility, and the project overview team included the Tulsa County Industrial Authority, the Tulsa County Board of Commissioners and Program Management Group, LLC.
